Learning How to Pray for the Nations

1. How do you think our prayers can impact other nations?

Read these verses:

- Matthew 9:37
- Matthew 6:10
- 2 Thessalonians 3:1-2

2. What do these verses say about what we should pray for and the impact of prayer on missions?

Preparing a World Prayer time:

Let's prepare a World Prayer time that you could use personally or lead an individual or group of people through.

3. What is a particular country or people group you would like to pray for?
 - Look up the country in Operation World and Joshua Project. (www.operationworld.org and www.joshuaproject.net)
 - **Statistics:** Write down the population size and the percentage of major religions.
 - **General Background:** Write down a short summary of this country's physical needs, economic struggles, political situation, and Christian persecution. You should be able to summarize this to the group if you are leading others to pray for this country.
 - **Praise God's work:** Write down 1-2 praises of what God has done so far.
 - **Prayer Requests:** Write down 3-5 prayer requests either given from the website or that you have come up with.
 - **Pray through Current Events:** Do an internet search for news in that country and write down at least one prayer request for a current event you can pray for.
 - **Pray for Missionaries:** Write down any missionaries you know that are working there, so you can pray for them specifically. If possible, find a recent prayer letter or contact the missionary for specific prayer requests. If you don't know of any, pray for laborers to go there.
4. Take 5-10 minutes and pray.

Ideas for praying daily for the nations:

- Rotate praying for different missionaries you know.
- Pick a country in Operation World and pray through the listed prayer requests.
- Look at international news and pray for areas of the world that are struggling.
- Pray for the persecuted church – www.persecution.com.
- Use the Joshua Project website or mobile app to pray for the unreached people group of the day.
